At times the scenery is much like that of southern England - but often with huge mountains as a backdrop. There are also unspoilt native forests which have an almost primeval feeling to them.

The RNLI celebrated its 200th anniversary in 2024: this talk looks at the 200 years through a selection of stories. These cover the events leading up to and the foundation of the RNLI; how early lifeboats operated and some highs and lows of the early years; its activity through the two world wars and the mechanisation of lifeboats; the introduction of women into lifeboat crews and prevention as one of the key developments of RNLI activity. The talk ends with a look at the modern training and equipment, the activity of lifeguards on our beaches and international work.
